




Project Limits and Primary Project Aspects




Alternatives Schedule Feedback



Alternatives Schedule Feedback

Phase A - The Initial Evaluation of Alternatives

- Establishes the need for an action
- A range of potential alternatives to achieve the need are developed
- Eliminates alternatives that are clearly not feasible



-NMDOT Location Study Procedures, 2015




Alternatives Schedule Feedback



Alternatives Schedule Feedback

Schedule

- July 11, 2024 Received Notice to Proceed
- Late Fall/Early Winter 30% Design
- Early 2025 60% Review
- Spring, 2025 90% Plans

Currently, no construction funding has been designated.

Project could move to 100% design and certification should funding become available
